CHALK IT UP! SHEBOYGAN IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Registration forms are due (with \$20 payment) July 1 to assure you a space and the T-shirt size you choose.** Registration forms are available at SVA on Final Fridays, at Mead Public Library, online at sheboyganvisualartists.com, or by mail (call Mari @ 920-254-4964) **Registration after July 1 cannot guarantee you a correctly sized t-shirt.** Registration will continue until no spaces are available. On-site registration will continue at the Registration Tent Saturday, July 16 at 7 am.
- **You may pay for your registration either by check, cash, or credit card. Send your filled out registration form with check in payment to SHEBOYGAN VISUAL ARTISTS, c/o Mari Rose, 1948 North 7th Street, Sheboygan, WI 53081. Do not send cash. If you wish to pay with cash or credit, fill out registration form and indicate that you will pay with cash or credit on the day of the event.** (Notice: credit card payments may be subject to a credit fee.)
- **Registration forms are available at Mead Public Library, or by mail from Mari Rose at (920) 254-4964 or (920) 457-3414 or email her at art.marirose@gmail.com**
- **KIDS CHALK IT UP! SHEBOYGAN** is a separate chalking event held for children 12 and under in conjunction with Chalk It Up! Sheboygan. **There are separate application forms, fees, rules, and awards for this event. This event is free of charge to children age 18 and under.**
- **ONE box of Pastel Chalk and ONE T-Shirt will be provided for each registered space.** Each space may include more than one artist, but only one t-shirt and 1 set of chalk will be provided per space. Additional shirts may be available for purchase at the event for \$10 each, subject to availability. Additional chalk may be available for purchase as well.
- **All participants must be registered and registration fees paid in full BEFORE being assigned a space.** Do not start work on the pavement until you have been assigned a space. The onsite Registration Tent will be open at 7 am on July 16.
- **Only CHALK can used for drawings.** No paint, crayon, ink or other non-washable or permanent products.
- **NO fixatives may be used on the chalk drawings.**
- **You may purchase or use your own chalk but it MUST be water-based AND APPROVED BY OUR REGISTRATION DESK.** If you need additional colors, you may share or exchange chalk with other participants. Additional Chalk may be available at the registration desk area for a fee, please ask the volunteers.
- **Chalk art is only to be produced in designated and assigned areas.** Participants may use all or part of the assigned space. All participants may register for an additional space, if they so choose, for an additional fee.
- **Chalk It Up! Volunteers will be around to assist you.** Do not hesitate to ask for chalk, water, etc.
- **The art created must be suitable for public and family viewing** (no nude or lewd work). No words or symbols intended as political statements may appear within the art.
- **Your chalk art must only include chalk.** Any non-chalk props will exclude art from judging.
- **Chalk art should be finished by 3:00 for judging.** Judges will judge what they see, whether your piece is finished or not.
- **Award presentations will take place on Saturday .** Saturday, all prizes will be presented at 5 p.m. at Mead Public Library.
- **The event will go on rain or shine. Only in case of severe weather, the festival may be cancelled - but unfortunately no refunds will be issued due to costs incurred.** Participants are responsible for protecting their chalk art. Plastic drapes, tape, tents or canopies can be used as needed, but will not be provided by Chalk It Up Sheboygan.
- **The Chalk It Up Sheboygan Committee reserves the right to refuse, stop or eliminate objectionable material.** The Chalk It Up Sheboygan Committee's opinion will be final. *(If artists have questions about their art, it is recommended that artists produce a paper copy of their art for approval prior to the event. Contact Mari at 920-254-4964 if you have questions about this.)*
- **Please respect the other artist participants who are working near you.** Do not walk on their paintings or have open beverage containers which could spill and destroy someone else's artwork.
- Please try to keep your supplies to a minimum and well contained by your space.
- **No boom boxes allowed.** You may wear portable headsets.
- **Please keep all pets under control and off the art work.**
- **Have a good time and enjoy the day!** Share your creativity with the members of the public. They came to see you! If you have any problems with spectators, please let our volunteers know and we'll be glad to help you.
