

KIDS CHALK IT UP! SHEBOYGAN IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- KIDS CHALK IT UP! SHEBOYGAN is a separate chalking event held for children 18 and under in conjunction with Chalk It Up! Sheboygan, and is sponsored by Mead Public Library. *There are separate application forms, fees, rules, and awards for this event.* This event is free of charge for children under 19.
- Chalk will be provided for each registered artist.
- **ALL Participants must register.** Do not start work on the pavement until you have been assigned a space. The onsite KIDS Registration Desk will be open at 9:30 am on July 16 at Mead Public Library.
- Only CHALK can used for drawings. No paint, crayon, ink or other non-washable or permanent products. Any nonchalk props will exclude art from judging.
- NO fixatives may be used on the chalk drawings.
- You may bring or use your own chalk but it MUST be water-based AND APPROVED BY OUR REGISTRATION DESK. If you need additional colors, you may share or exchange chalk with other participants.
- Chalk art is only to be produced in designated and assigned areas. Participants may use all or part of the assigned space.
- Volunteers will be around to assist you. DO NOT hesitate to ask for chalk, water, etc.
- The art created must be **suitable for public and family viewing** (no nude or lewd work). No words or symbols intended as political statements may appear within the art.
- Chalk art should be finished by <u>noon</u> for judging. Judges will judge what they see, whether the piece is finished or not.
- Award presentations will take place on at 12:30 pm Saturday at Mead Public Library.
- The event will go on rain or shine. Only in case of severe weather, the festival may be cancelled but unfortunately no refunds will be issued due to costs incurred. Participants are responsible for protecting their chalk art. Plastic drapes, tape, tents or canopies can be used as needed, but will not be provided by Kids Chalk It Up Sheboygan.
- The Kids Chalk It Up Sheboygan Committee and Mead Public Library reserves the right to refuse, stop or
 eliminate objectionable material. Their opinion will be final. (If artists have questions about their art, it is
 recommended that artists produce a paper copy of their art for approval <u>prior</u> to the event.)
- Please respect the other artist participants who are working near you. Do not walk on their paintings or have open beverage containers which could spill and destroy someone else's artwork.
- Please try to keep your supplies to a minimum and well contained by your space.
- No boom boxes allowed. You may wear portable headsets.
- Please keep any pets under control and off the art work.
- **Have a good time and enjoy the day!** Share your creativity with the members of the public. They came to see you! If you have any problems with spectators, please let our volunteers know and we'll be glad to help you.
